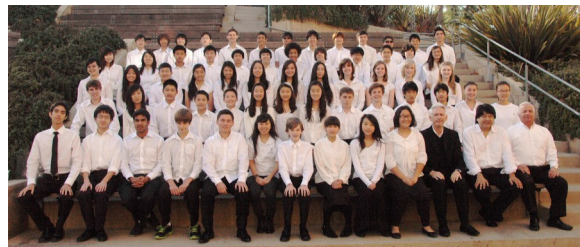
About AASA

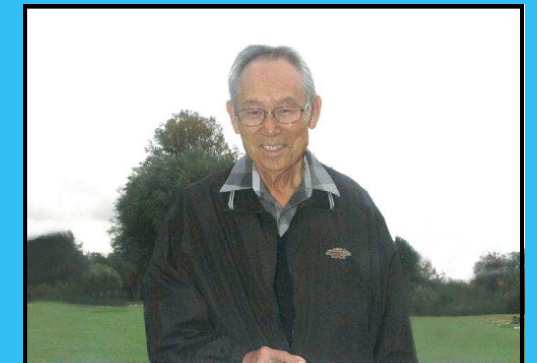
